



Protect your Rubis Tweezers

TAKING CARE OF TWEEZERS IN 3 STEPS:

Clean thoroughly after each use.

Always put the protective cap on after use.

Store your tweezers carefully.

Avoid impacts and falls.

Do not use your tweezers for any other purpose.

- Avoid falls: Tweezers are precise tools that have a delicate tip. Be careful not to drop your tweezers or hit them against hard surfaces to prevent deformation.
- Protective cap: always use the cap we provide after use to protect the tip of the tweezers.
- Clean and disinfect your tweezers regularly: you should clean and disinfect your tweezers regularly to kill bacteria and germs. Use alcohol or a suitable disinfectant for this purpose. Make sure the tweezers are dry before you use them again.
- Store your tweezers safely: Avoid leaving your tweezers lying around in the open to prevent damage. Instead, store them in a clean, dry place to protect them from dust, dirt, and moisture.
- Do not use your tweezers for other purposes: Our tweezers are designed for cosmetic use. Do not use them for other purposes, such as opening packages or gripping heavy objects. This can bend or damage them.
- The most used solution is isopropyl alcohol (containing 60-70% alcohol), at this concentration it is a very effective antibacterial disinfectant.
- Gentle cleaning: Use a soft, clean, non-abrasive cloth to apply the solution to the surface of the products.
 Avoid hard or rough materials, abrasive brushes or sponges that could scratch the coating.
- Avoid soaking or prolonged immersion: Avoid prolonged soaking of products in cleaning agents or solutions as this may damage the coating.
- Dry quickly: Allow the products to air dry after applying isopropyl alcohol or a suitable solution. Do not use tools or cloths that may absorb too much liquid and leave a residue.
